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Key Chain - Tutorial.



You need:

- A piece of felt: 6,5cm x 13cm
- Ribbon: 20 cm reversible satin ribbon, 28mm wide, and 20 cm reversible satin ribbon 10mm wide.
- Key ring. Diameter: 36mm.
- 3 letter beads.
- 1 piece of fabric. Of 6 by 6 cm and a piece of interface of the same size.
- Felt flower with a width of about 5 cm. We used a ready-made one but of course you can make your own. We included a template of the right size for you at the bottom of the next page.
- 1 circle template with a diameter of 5 cm (e.g. made of cardboard or maybe you have a lid/glass with this diameter) and one circle template with a diameter of 6 cm.
- Yarn matching the chosen colour combination.

- Marker.
- Pinking shears.

This is how it's done:

1. Iron the interface onto the back of the piece of fabric.
2. Draw the 5cm circle on the back of the fabric and cut it out with the pinking shears. Draw the 6cm circle twice on the felt and cut these two circles out with normal scissors. Now you'll have three circles: one of fabric measuring 5 cm, 2 of felt measuring 6 cm.
3. Put the fabric circle onto one of the felt circles. Place the felt flower on top and secure these layers in the middle with a couple of stitches.
4. Now, it's time for the letter beads. Arrange them next to each other in the middle of the felt flower. Sew the first bead on, check the position and then add the second and third. Secure tightly. At this point it's also recommendable to secure the fabric circle to the felt circle in some more places to avoid curling later on. You can easily do this by hand under 2 or 3 of the flower petals. This way the stitches remain invisible.
5. Take the two pieces of ribbon and decide on the colour arrangement (the ribbons are reversible). Place the narrow ribbon in the middle of the broader one, secure with some pins and then sew it on.
6. Pull the ribbon through the key ring and place the ends on each other.
7. Place the two ribbon ends in between the felt circles. Secure with a couple of pins and then neatly stitch the two felt circles together.
